As a resident on Dona Ana County, I would like solid and scientifically backed studies on the actual impacts of Bloom Energy deployment before NMED approves the methane fueled power plants for Yucca Growth Infrastructure. Pollution levels for these fuel cell units has only been tested at small scale levels with 65kw, as opposed to the 1.4GW currently deployed at more than a thousand locations with these fuel cells currently or the 2.46gw proposed for this application. This means the power plant would be 37,000 times larger than the test unit. The people of Santa Teresa and the county should be given clear, honest explanations for how much heat this will generate and how much air pollution will be caused. Please add 60 days to the review period so more research can be conducted, and deny the air quality permit application until the public has an honest analysis of how 2.46GW of methane consuming fuel cells would actually impact the air quality of Doña Ana County.
