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Project Jupiter is highly problematic and harmful for our air quality and environmental health. The emissions of methane and the other toxic chemicals released by the newly proposed fuel cells is just as dangerous as fossil fuels. Hold an open hearing so that actual New Mexicans can have a say! Let the voices of the people who will be affected by the decision to allow the data center to be built and used be heard! Do NOT hurt, damage, and silence us just for the benefit of the few, the wealthy, and the corrupt! Look at the record of this company for its consistent failure to comply with regulations and stop it from happening in our beautiful state to the detriment of everyone and our already fragile ecosystem! ACT FOR THE PEOPLE and reject this company to infiltrate our community. The people are counting on you. Don't let us, the future, and our air quality suffer from unnecessary and dangerous "advancements" in the interest of the greedy. Regulate with more in mind than money and appeasing the powerful and rich corporations!

The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste.

If the permit is not denied, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.

Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism as residents of Doña Ana County are already disproportionately impacted by environmental pollution.
