To fulfill your agency mission, you should outright deny their permits required for project, Jupiter, and if needed extend more time for public comment. To approve the permits would be to Act in contravention to your organizational mission, and would constitute a violation of the statute creating agency.

NMED's Air Quality Bureau "protects the public health of New Mexicans and the natural beauty of the state by preventing the deterioration of air quality."

If the permit is not denied at this time, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
