I am writing to urge the NMED to reject YUCCA Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid.

NMED should deny this application because granting it would allow operations that will increase air pollution and adversely affect public health and local environmental conditions. Before any permit is issued, the applicant must demonstrate—clearly and comprehensively—that emissions impacts are fully characterized, adequately controlled, and within applicable limits for all relevant pollutants and operating conditions.

For these reasons, I respectfully request that NMED reject the application and require the company to submit a new filing that addresses deficiencies and provides robust, enforceable protections for air quality.
