Thank you for allowing us the chance to comment on this proposed grid and other Projects Jupiter associated proposals.

I would like to voice my concerns for usage of New Mexico's resources and environment for this data center and its sub-projects. As an engineer, and former intern at EMNRD, I don't trust this proposal given Project Jupiter and "Yucca Growth Infrastructure LLC's" history. (Past proposals that were later found to be vastly underestimating environmental impacts). I'll add the caveat that I have a general public level of awareness of the inner workings of the project, but from my understanding through reports from others accounts, this project lacks the community's trust, there appears to be much concern from most of the people in the area. People need to come first in New Mexico.

I am concerned that this project will negatively affect our environment, our natural resource security (like water and energy), and our government (I don't trust the companies involved to play by the rules).

There needs to be full transparency, clear government regulation and community inclusion before this should be allowed to move forward. New Mexico should get a clear and lasting benefit to the communities. Unless the community is satisfied, this project (and any Oracle/OpenAI backed data centers) should be rejected.
