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Our community does not support this project, and the damage it will cause to our local environment and quality of life. This ecosystem is already in a vulnerable state due to consistent droughts, and taking from our aquifers and water table for cooling at this facility, will only further worsen already unsustainable drought conditions. The high levels of dust stemming from the dry conditions here, as well as the strong winds already contribute to poor air quality, a data center's exhaust will only serve to worsen these issues, while putting off massive amounts of heat. We also have an unstable power grid, and that would be greatly exacerbated by a massive data center using far more power than the entire city itself. All of these problems are readily apparent to many members of this community, causing massive public backlash to this project, and in return, we are getting a few jobs for a select group of people (which I happen to even be a part of as a computer technologies major). This is not the proper environment or community for a data center of this scale. Please listen to the community and do not approve any part of this "project jupiter".
