My name is Andrew Bramble. I live in Cerrillos NM. I've followed Project Jupiter since propaganda for the project began infesting my social media feed.

NMED should reject Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's application for an air quality permit for the YGI Microgrid. NMED's mission is "to protect and restore the environment and to foster a healthy and prosperous New Mexico for present and future generations." Granting these permit applications is a direct contradiction to that mission.

The YGI Microgrid will release million of tons of climate-warming greenhouse gasses each year. It will also generate enormous amounts of hazardous waste. All this within a few miles of Santa Teresa schools.
