- What is treated industrial non-potable water and what is its source?
- Project Jupiter will use on-site power generation supported by Bloom Energy fuel cells. What does supported by mean?
- What are the inputs and outputs of the Bloom Energy fuel cells? How do the outputs affect the local environment, especially air quality?
- If given air permit approval, how will NMED monitor the project and what will happen if the project goes out of compliance?

I urge the New Mexico Environment Department to conduct and publish further detailed evaluation of Project Jupiter before permits are awarded.
