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Please do not go forward with the Jupiter project or any data center endeavors. There are great environmental repercussions, the Rio Grande is already bone dry, and Texas is taking our water as it is too. The pollution it creates are not worth what these things are used for. People make child porn and other horrible things with AI and we will be hosting that on our land. There are no regulations for AI that actually hold companies and anyone turning a profit off of polluting our air and water, and killing animals in the environment. New Mexico has a history of being an outlet for pollutants and experimentation that has harmed our people- we must not continue the same mistakes. Aside from all this, you will be investing in a technology that is in a KNOWN bubble that will burst sometime soon. You will also be investing in a technology that is ruining critical thinking, media literacy, and human connection. AI is controlled by a few people who get to decide what is allowed to be fed into it. That is to say a few people are deciding what information gets to be known, and can manipulate it however they want. You can look at the example in which Grock was changed to constantly talk about a "white genocide" in South Africa as a current event. However, it was something that never took place. The US president and many others believe it to be true. You will be a part of this legacy if you go forward with the project. I ask NMED to reject YUCCA Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid. At the very least the public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so that community members can participate equitably.
