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We have watched data centers pop up all over the country and we have seen the same story play out each time. The data centers are run under a shell company owned by a massive tech firm. The big firm rolls into town with massive promises. They work extremely close with leaders, excluding the citizens using closed town halls, or having elected representatives sign NDAs. They make a bunch of pretty PowerPoint presentations, ads and pay influencers promising jobs, economic development, civil development. If you're lucky they at least use local labor to build the centers. Of course they don't spend time training any of the people who live in the town, so the jobs never really show up. They show up, steal water, pollute the air, create noise pollution. Data centers are designed to drain every drop of value from a community, all before leaving communities to clean up after they are gone. It's Einstein's definition of insanity. Why in the world would you trust anyone who has already lied and tricked your neighbors, especially when they are using the same lies to trick you.
