My name is hazie, I live near new Mexico, I am writing as I am concerned about the negative effects that project jupiter will have on new Mexicans. I am submitting this comment to urge the New Mexico Environment Department to reject Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid in Doña Ana County.

I care a great amount about the state of our environment, the growing concerns caused by climate change and it's effect on people. The project's proposed fuel cell powered grid is concerning for many reasons:

The project would still produce alarmingly high levels of greenhouse gases and toxic pollutants, moreover there has been no clear or confirmed way to handle the toxic waste it will produce, granting this permit for this project despite this would be reckless.

There are schools within 5 miles of this project, and the children who attend here will be left unfairly vulnerable to worrying health impacts of NOX, CO and VOCs

The air will be heavily effected and this serves as an injustice to them and the communities near the project who will be left to live in such undesirable conditions.

This project will cause more air pollution than the two consumer electrical grids that power new Mexican families and businesses, and the effects will be nothing short of horrid to the environment and the people.

Additionally, Approving this permit would be government sponsored environmental racism - the residents of Doña Ana County are already negatively affected by environmental pollution, it would be a disservice to grant this permit for the project knowing this.
