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The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit, so that community members can participate equitably. The air quality permit application should be rejected due to Bloom Energy's history of illegally dumping hazardous waste. If the permit is not rejected, a public hearing must be held in Santa Teresa , in both English and Spanish, with the option to participate online. Approving this permit would be government-backed environmental racism , because the people of Doña Ana County already suffer too much from environmental pollution. For years, Doña Ana County has been called a 'non-compliance' zone—this means that our air quality does not meet federal government rules. The people do not want data centers. As elected officials, your job is to represent your people. Your refusal to do so will result in the loss of public trust and respect. Do the right thing. Stop decimating the southwest, this country, and the world for the profit of a few who do not have the best interests in mind for you, myself, or your children.
