I am writing to oppose the Yucca Growth Infrastructure permit proposal. This is not a new air pollution permit. The people/corporations backing Project Jupiter plan to power their hyperscale data center with Bloom Energy's Solid Oxide Fuel Cells and have applied for a new air permit under the name Yucca Growth Infrastructure (YGI). Their power plant will still emit 10 million metric tons of CO2 every year. That's more than 20 billion pounds. More than the EPE and PNM electric grid combined. Still more than the total emissions of Albuquerque, Las Cruces and Santa Fe put together, making a mockery of New Mexico's emissions reduction goals and erasing all the progress that has been made over two decades.

Please, for the sake of the people of NM, and the planet, say NO to this permit application. We do not want these "microgrids" in our communities.
