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Project Jupiter is fundamentally unacceptable for the world we live in. In New Mexico, we don't have enough resources to host any data center without it being detrimental to the community from water to air. The people running Project Jupiter have no understanding or empathy for the destruction of environments and peoples lives that they cause. All people, namely New Mexicans, deserve an environment that is safe, respected and clean for us to live in. Say, "No," to Project Jupiter in any form, especially for the air quality application given their history of illegal and hazardous dumping. We need an extra 60 days for public review for this, so more people can research and comment on this (likely) environmental catastrophe. If the application isn't denied, there needs to be a public hearing in Santa Teresa (available in English and Spanish) with the option to attend virtually.
