Dear NMED staff, My name is Rebecca Kightlinger. I am writing because I am concerned about the risks and harms Project Jupiter poses to New Mexicans. Project Jupiter poses serious and irreversible harm to our planet. Project Jupiter's power plant will release up to 10 million tons of climate-warming greenhouse gasses every year. This would make a mockery of NM's climate goals, and erase most of the climate progress we have made in the last two decades. The potential harm being done far out ways the benefits. The choice YOU make WILL seriously affect the future generations of this planet. Speaking of the future generations, Santa Teresa Elementary and High School are located within five miles of this project site. 96% of students at the high school are hispanic. There are also day care centers located within miles of this site. This is an environmental injustice to these children who are especially vulnerable to the health impacts of NOX, CO, and VOCs. We do NOT want Oracle and Open AI sacrificing our communities to make tech-billionaires richer. I am submitting this comment to urge the New Mexico Environment Department to reject Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid in Doña Ana County.
