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Stop using AI. We don't need datacenters more than the air we breathe. More than the water we drink, more than the environment and all the inhabitants that occupy that space. It shouldn't be a contest to see what will pass our scope of what we as the people should tolerate from money-hungry, selfish, egotistical monsters that only think of their "goal" without considering and accommodating for the MILLIONS of lives they are crippling. This is public land. We have the right to refuse. So we should band together and say NO to the corruption of our ONLY habitable plant.

The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County.

If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
