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The construction of the Project Jupiter data center will be detrimental to local ecosystems and communities. New Mexico's desert habitat is home to so many crucial plant and animal species. Moreover, a new data center would put further strain on water resources in the area, and pose a risk for noise pollution. The community is overwhelmingly against the construction of this data center. The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality allowing so community members can participate equitably. The air quality permit application should be denied given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. If the permit is not denied, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa , in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
