I strongly urge you to deny the air quality permits for Project Jupiter in Doña Ana County.

The plan involves two natural gas plants that would emit over 14 million tons of greenhouse gases annually—more than Albuquerque and Las Cruces combined. This directly undermines New Mexico's clean energy goals. Worse, splitting the project into two "minor" sources seems like a tactic to dodge strict pollution monitoring, even while our county already struggles with a failing air quality grade.
