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This dependancy on AI needs to stop. We've lived years without it, and now with projects such as Project Jupiter, we're only assuring people that AI is a needed tool when it is not at all. It's terribly harmful to our environment, and many communities are already suffering because of it. If we allow this big of a data center to be created, the effects on the environment and society would be irreversible.

The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County.

If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
