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Stop the building of the Jupiter data center! Only irreparable harm will occur due to the mass of carbon dioxide exposed annually and who is to deal with it? Those in the surrounding communities who will have to suffer the consequences. The climate crisis is suffering enough there is no need for more data centers!

New Mexico Environment Department should give the public an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County.

If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
