Please deny this permit. The amount of emissions for this permit will dramatically effect in a negative way human health and environment health. Air quality in this area of the state is already some of the worst in the entire United States and I cannot from a moral standpoint or a scientific standpoint accept any project that will make air quality worse here. Additionally, Ysleta del Sur Pueblo, the Piro-Manso-Tiwa, Tortugas Pueblo, the Chiricahua Apache, and Mescalero Apache all merit having a significant seat at the table for consultation on this project.

Additionally, I raise concerns about the use of Bloom fuel cells to power this project. These types of fuel cells have never been used at this enormous of a scale before. I am concerned that there will be unexpected air quality and environmental impacts due to the use of fuel cells that cannot be anticipated at this time. This would make New Mexico land and New Mexicans a lab rat for testing by this company. This is morally outrageous to me. Please deny this permit. At minimum, please hold a public hearing for this air permit.
