I am asking that you deny Yucca Growth Infrastructure's air quality permit as this will only damage the communities nearby and will worsen climate change.

For years, Doña Ana County has been called a 'nonattainment' zone— this means our air quality does not meet federal government rules. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism as residents of Doña Ana County are already disproportionately impacted by environmental pollution.

New Mexico Environment Department should provide the public with an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

If the permit is not denied, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
