Hi, I'm writing as a lifelong NM resident to express my strong opposition to Project Jupiter, and to ask that you REJECT the LLC-YGI Microgrid Air Quality Construction Permit Application from Yucca Growth Infrastructure. New Mexicans need clean water and air, not AI infrastructure that will primarily create value for the already wealthy, and increasingly fuels surveillance, violation of intellectual property through nonconsensual use of artist's work, and crimes against humanity - see Project Lavender, Gospel, and Where's Daddy, all used in Israel's genocide against the Palestinian people. Google's Project Nimbus empowered the same genocidal state with AI, and recently contracted with CBP to bring these tools to our southern border. What the people of Gaza have been subjected to is absolutely horrifying, and I don't want it for anyone, much less my neighbors and people who are chasing the American dream.

In addition, our state's water situation is highly concerning, even without siphoning off our most precious resource to cool a hyper scale facility such as the one proposed. Between multiple Superfund sites, and our river going dry for the third year in a row, we simply cannot afford it. 30 decent-paying long term jobs are not a fair trade for the massive heat outputs, air pollution equivalent to our 3 largest cities, and harm to our already threatened water supply.

I find the disingenuous use of social media influencers as hired propaganda, and false attribution of people's names in support to be deeply offensive, and a clear indicator that the architects of this project do not respect our residents.
