Because of this I am urging the New Mexico Environment Department to reject Yucca Growth Infrastructure, LLC's air permit application for the YGI Microgrid in Doña Ana County.

The project's proposed fuel cell powered grid is concerning to me because:

Fuel cell technology or a centralized waste system has never been tried at this scale.
