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Project Jupiter will put New Mexico in unnecessary danger. New Mexico is already in a drought building a data center will make our water resources scarce. Las Vegas is already having water troubles due to the fires we are too dry of a state to be adding this center.

The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County.

If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
