Thank you for the opportunity to comment. After reading background information on Project Jupiter and their subsequent requests for permits regarding air quality and construction I believe the Dona Ana county needs a higher level of review. I do not support the approval of the permitting for this project.

Project Jupiter continues to advertise benefits to the community with minimal facts of their resource needs and impacts over a timeline for the foreseeable future. At this time data center proponents have whitewashed facts of water use, electricity use and other resources impacts. Nation wide data centers have misrepresented their construction and operational needs.

I do not support Project Jupiter. There is a better way to engineer data centers with less resource impacts, namely less water. Potentially data centers could use Produced Water from fracking, thus resolving part of the problem with an abundance of Produced Water from fracking practices. Currently PW is not potable. Project Jupiter should consider other means to support their business and not rely on taking advantage of small communities or rely on fact distortion.
