Good morning,

I am writing to inform you that the previous comment submitted under my name was **not** submitted by me. I do not know who impersonated me to submit that comment on my behalf but they did not even include my correct contact information (they only provided a phone number of 201-740-8570, which is not mine). I was not even aware of this project until I received an email confirming my response to this public comment period on my business email. As I own a business in New Mexico my information was likely scraped from public records. If some other comments are to be believed, this may be by representatives of the permit requestor themselves as an attempt to skew the RFC record.

I called in through the NMED primary phone number and was directed to comment again here to set the record straight. For the record:

- The previous comment submitted under my name do not reflect my views and was not authorized by me
- I am not a resident of Doña Ana County
- I **do not** support Project Jupiter or the YGI Microgrid
- I **do not** support the build of any AI-focused datacenter due to the disproportionate impact to environment, well-being of residents, and extremely limited water resources

In regards to the impersonation of myself or other members of our state, should any legal action be necessary, the matter should be referred to the New Mexico Attorneys General. If a public hearing is scheduled (virtually or physically) then I will attend to echo out these details and call attention to the fraud being committed against the State of New Mexico and the affected members of the local community. I must urge that all comments following the same form-letter style submitted under all persons be reviewed and summarily rejected.
