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Please halt Project Jupiter. The public should be giving an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably. The air quality permit should be denied given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. The residents of Dona Ana County are already disproportionately impacted by environmental pollution and New Mexico's water supply is beyond depletion. The land and air cannot withstand this project. If the permit is not denied, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both spanish and english, with an option to participate virtually. Bloom Energy has been fined a total of \$1.4 million dollars for illegally storing, transporting, and dumping this hazardous waste in several states AND falsifying records over many years to cover it up.
