I am strongly opposed to granting the air quality permit for the Yucca Growth Infrastructure Microgrid. Living along the southern Rio Grande as a Dona Ana County resident for more than two decades, my family has been shocked to see firsthand of how quickly the pervasive extreme drought and lack of year round flow in the river has severely shrunk the water table of the Mesilla Valley and desiccated once thriving native vegetation and habitat for wildlife. We already struggle to keep our intentionally drought-tolerant landscape alive, and believe that the substantial stresses Project Jupiter will put on our fragile water supply and related energy demands will severely impact all county residents, both near to the project area and beyond. The actual facts offered by the developers throughout this process so far have been elusive, misleading, and constantly mutating and I believe that much more true fact-finding and truth-telling is urgently needed before any more permits are granted.
