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this is completely unfair to people who did not ask for this, the animals, nature, or even our own planet we live on. approving this permit would be government sponsored environmental racism as residents of doña ana county already are disproportionately impacted by environmental pollution. the air quality permit application should be denied given bloom energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste..the public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably. if the permit isn't denied, a PUBLIC hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in BOTH english & spanish. with an option to participate virtually aswell. for years, doña ana county has been called a non attainment zone, meaning that our air quality doesn't meet federal government rules. please do better. for yourselves, our community, for the people, for the earth, and your friends and family.
