NMED must categorically reject the project Jupiter data center. New Mexicans have made their opposition clear, the toll this data center would have on our environment and resources is outrageous. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism as residents of Doña Ana County are already disproportionately impacted by environmental pollution.
