I'm writing as a concerned resident who is trying to understand what Project Jupiter means for our community. I'm not a technical expert, but the information available so far makes me uneasy about the scale of this project and how it could affect our air quality, health, and natural resources.

Many of us already worry about pollution and respiratory issues in Doña Ana County, and adding two gas-powered plants feels like a big change with long-term consequences. It's also hard to understand why the project needs two separate permits when both facilities seem to be part of the same operation. That makes the process feel confusing and less transparent.

I'm also concerned about how fast this project is moving and how little clear information the public has received about things like water use, the gas pipeline, and overall environmental impacts. A project this large should come with more openness and more chances for the community to fully understand what's being proposed.

I respectfully ask NMED to take extra care with this decision, make sure the public has complete information, and ensure that the health and wellbeing of local residents come first.
