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Project Jupiter as currently planned will use solid oxide fuel cells for the conversion of LNG into electrical power. This approach will produce electrical power with a price point that is approximately 3 times more than the MW/hr price point of wind, or solar generation. Geothermal can generate a price point that is approximately 58% the price point of LNG. NM has enormous potential for solar, wind and geothermal electrical generation. It is farcical, that NM should ignore these local sources of clean, affordable and abundant power in favor of a dirty and expensive LNG fuel solution. The economics do not support the power solution that has been chosen to operate Project Jupiter. The enormous polluting effect of LNG usage will not benefit the people of NM and will further increase the State's mean temperature thus causing more energy consumption for heat pump operation, in the form of air conditioning and refrigeration. The foolishness of the proposed LNG solution in light of our abundant clean local power potential which is readily available for development can only be explained in terms of a "carpet bagger" mentality that benefits out of state energy companies at the expense of the citizens of New Mexico.
