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This is depressing and deplorable behavior, we don't need it. Children are suffering, the elderly don't have care, war is rampant and people are dying. Who will use this when we are all dead? Who will it cater to? Who will still be alive to use it? The public should be given an additional 60 days to review and comment on the air quality permit so community members can participate equitably.

The air quality permit application should be denied outright given Bloom Energy's history of illegal dumping hazardous waste. Approving this permit would be government-sponsored environmental racism directed at residents of Doña Ana County.

If the permit is not denied outright, a public hearing needs to be held in Santa Teresa, in both English and Spanish, with an option to participate virtually.
