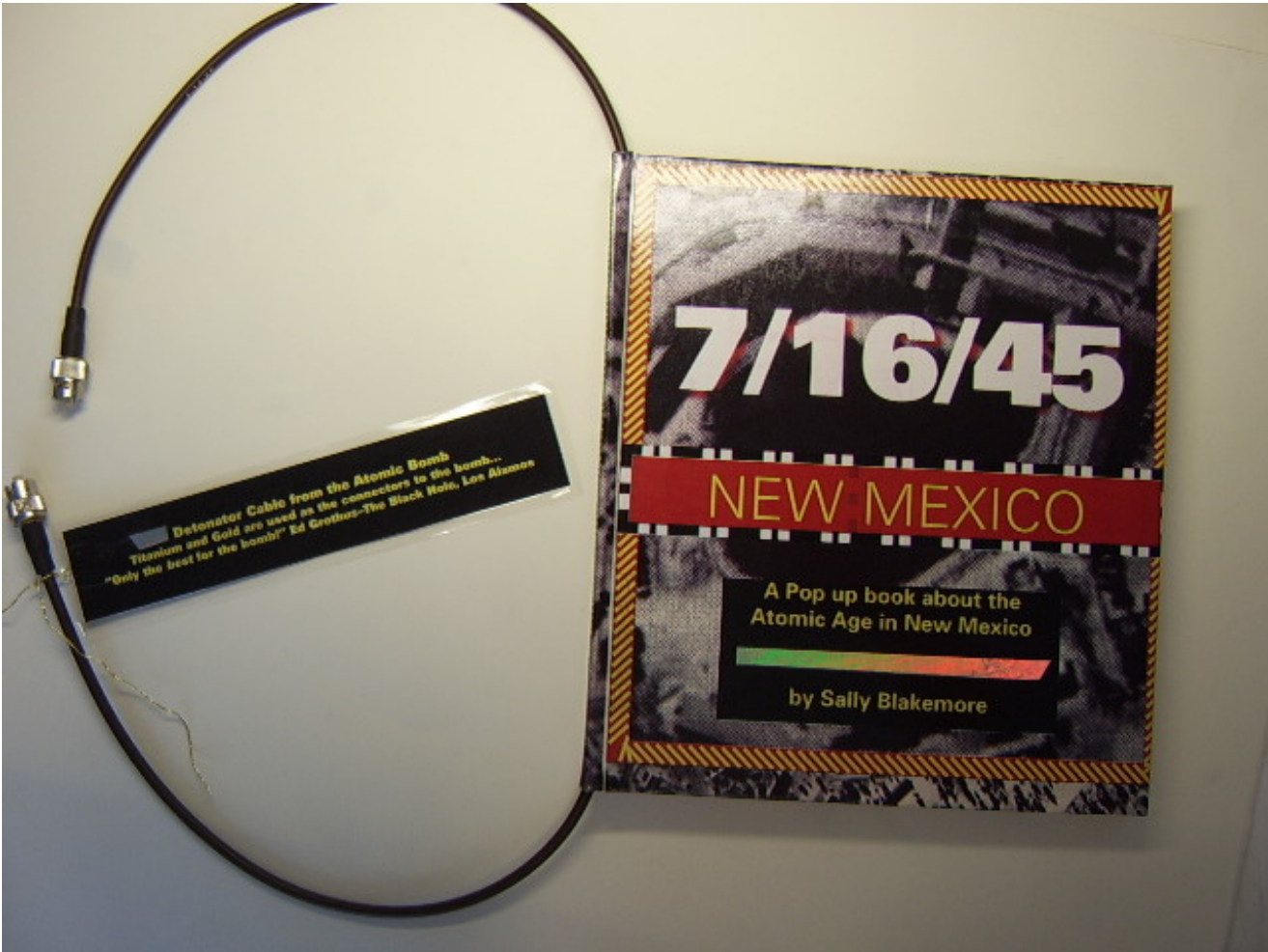


Sally Blakemore
