Hello, I very much support the New Mexico Environment Department's recent modification of the DOE WIPP permit, which requires that all the legacy waste in 2,500 drums in tents at LANL must be transported to WIPP by July 1, 2028. I commend the NMED for this permit modification, which tells the DOE that they must take New Mexico residents' safety and health seriously. DOE is already legally responsible for this, but they have not been demonstrating this. The penalty if DOE fails to accomplish the modification is important because DOE has shown it will ignore its agreement with New Mexico if it is not held accountable.
