I am opposed to using treated frack water for ag use.

Produced water contains a complex mix of contaminants including salts, heavy metals, naturally occurring radioactive materials and chemicals which can vary dramatically from one well.

The rules do not prescribe specific treatment technologies and testing for radionuclides, PFAS or "forever chemicals," heavy metals or other contaminants commonly found in oilfield wastewater. The rules point to a lack of legal liability by any party involved.

This proposal is merely off-loading the problem and is not a viable solution.
