While it's important that these are available to residents without (or with spotty) internet access, making copies of the materials adds up cost-wise and taking photos of the relevant pages is very cumbersome. That's why it's equally important to have all related application materials posted online...and for every permit application. If large files are an issue for the applicant, they can provide a link or use a free transfer service to send the files to interested individuals.
