Public roads and streets outside quarry facilities MUST be kept free of aggregate dust and fine materials that create a safety hazard to vehicles traversing the roads. When wet, from rain or water drippings from the exiting trucks, the build up of dust creates a slippery condition. Require regular sweeping for 1/4 mile along the paved public road at a defined frequency (or base it on the number of exiting trucks) that will prevent the buildup of the safety hazard.
