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I support TCEQ's efforts to modernize outdated regulations, eliminate obsolete provisions, and improve administrative efficiency. At the same time, regulatory modernization should maintain or strengthen environmental protection, public health, and transparency. As these rules are revised, I encourage TCEQ to: (1) document that environmental protections are maintained or improved; (2) expand opportunities for water conservation, reclaimed water use, and drought resilience; (3) maintain robust monitoring and compliance requirements when permitting is streamlined; (4) ensure electronic reporting improves public access to environmental information; (5) incorporate modern engineering practices and climate resilience into updated technical standards; and (6) periodically review rules to reflect advances in environmental science and technology. These measures would allow Texas to achieve greater regulatory efficiency while continuing to protect its natural resources and support long-term sustainability.
