- 1. It is not clear what type if any copper processing such as smelting will be done onsite. I understand an analysis might be required if primary copper smelting, and or secondary copper smelting is done on site.. If onsite processing done, I do not see in The Trinity modeling an analysis of the nonferrous metals-zinc, cadmium, and beryllium. Please address if appropriate.
- 2. What will the dollar value of the bond be and how was the amount calculated? I believe the amount of the bond should be calculated at the end of the 44 year life of the mine and should be based on the dollar amount at that time and not in current dollars. The bond should be sufficient and required to move the rock waste and other debris back into the mine pits, and then contour the area back as close as possible to the original contours and top with sufficient top soil for planting back trees and scrubs
