ADEQ must reject the proposed air-pollution permit for the Copper World mine. The draft permit does little to ensure the mine protects our air or environment. At bare a minimum, you must require the Copper World mine to obtain a Class I permit, so that the mine is \*always\* accountable for limiting its air pollution and protecting the environment — no exceptions. The proximity of this mine to population centers, tribal lands, important agriculture and Saguaro National Park demand more rigorous regulation of its emissions.
