Dear ADEQ,

I urge ADEQ to deny the permit for the proposed Aluminum Dynamics plant in Benson based on unavoidable environmental and safety risks:

- 1. The plant is located on a known fault line, creating unavoidable seismic risks for any underground chemical storage.
- 2. The proposed 90-foot-deep chemical melting/casting pit sits at or below the high local water table (~70 feet), placing the aquifer in direct jeopardy.
- 3. Seasonal monsoons raise the water table, further reducing the natural buffer between chemicals and groundwater.
- 4. The combination of depth, chemical storage, and geological factors creates an irreducible long-term risk of aquifer contamination.

These are physical and environmental constraints that cannot be mitigated. Allowing this project would endanger Benson's drinking water and surrounding communities. I strongly urge ADEQ to deny all permits for this facility.
