A secure and safe working environment can be achieved without detriment to neighbors quality of life, wildlife or property values simply by adhering to the principles of responsible outdoor lighting. Outdoor lighting should be designed to point down, avoiding skyglow, glare and light trespass onto neighboring properties. Only the minimum amount of light necessary should be installed and it should only be lit when in use. Use timers, motion sensors and full cut-off shielding. Be a good neighbor. 96cy
