Hello - as a winery and vineyard owner, we believe that in the peak spraying season (roughly June-September), there are days when a 24 hour notice of spraying is not feasible. For example, if we notice an infestation of mealy bug, we would make an immediate determination to spray, thus unable to provide a 24 hour notice. In addition, the agriculture industry is inundated with requirements and restrictions, all of which are important for consumer/applicator protection, but also burdensome to implement in a very hectic and busy time period. It would seem that some type of compromise would be preferable.
