As a resident of California and community advocate, I urge you to create a fully transparent pesticide notification system where upcoming pesticide application information is available to all, including the exact location of the application site, so that we can take appropriate precautions. SprayDays notifications will only be useful if residents can take appropriate action to protect themselves, and we can only do that if we know exactly where and when we will be at risk of pesticide exposure. Please include exact field locations in notifications so that Californians can take actionable steps to ensure the safety of themselves and their families. This information is also needed for pesticide spraying in public areas in California--our parks and roadways. Our TAXES fund these areas and our government agencies.
