With DPR "required training," this parallels the training component of the Healthy Schools Act (HSA). I would like to see DPR (UC ANR) provide the training, as well as approved courses offered by qualified others. This training must have SPCB/CDPR and CDPH (Vector) CE credit attached to it.

Regrading the 35-day x 3= 105 day intervals. Studies at DPR sites show that 70% of rodent infestations are controlled within 35 days. Successful control efforts require removal of 95%> of the population. I would like to see a definition of pulse baiting prescribed in the training. Would the requirement of 35 days with a maximum of 105 days be flexible, as an example, employing bait for two weeks and removing for two week but not to exceed 105 days total?
