Californians have already demanded poison-free solutions. DPR must honor the law. Repealing prohibition of rodenticides, except during a declared public health or environmental emergency is in defiance of all current science and a threat to both humans and animals. Rollbacks of AB 1788, AB 2552, or AB 1322 is NOT acceptable. Further,

California must invest in ecological rodent control to protect raptors and other predators, not more poison. Anticoagulants are toxic and non-selective, killing the very wildlife that naturally controls rodents.

DPR is legally obligated to protect wildlife, not poison it.

Allowing use of poison ensures continued contamination of predators, pets, and ecosystems for years to come.
