I urge you to ban all anticoagulant rodenticides with no exemptions to expand them. Even with existing restrictions, anticoagulant rodenticides continue to kill and harm non-target animals — including mountain lions, bobcats, owls, and endangered San Joaquin kit foxes — through painful internal bleeding by secondary poisoning.

California does not need to rely on cruel, outdated poisons. Integrated Pest Management strategies — for example, sealing buildings, removing food and water sources, and employing non-toxic controls such as contraceptives, snap traps, and electric traps — are humane and cost-effective solutions.
