Please continue current law that No anticoagulant rodenticide be allowed, except during a declared public health or environmental emergency. No rollback of AB 1788, AB 2552, or AB 1322 is acceptable. California must invest in ecological rodent control to protect raptors and predators, not more poison, which can also end up in ground water.

Anticoagulants are toxic and non-selective, killing the very wildlife that naturally controls rodents. DPR is legally obligated to protect wildlife, not poison it. Allowing 100+ days of poison use ensures continued contamination of predators, pets, and ecosystems. Californians have already demanded poison-free solutions, so DPR must honor the law.
